THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS



1. Equality
Everyone is born free and equal in dignity and with rights.



2. Freedom from discrimination
No one should ever be discriminated against for any reason.



3. Life, Liberty and Security
Everyone has the right to life, liberty and personal security.



4. Freedom from slavery
No one shall be in slavery or servitude.



5. Freedom from torture
No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel or degrading treatment.



6. Recognition as person before law
Everyone has the right to be treated as a person in the eyes of the law.



7. Equality before the law
Everyone has the right to be treated by the law in the same way.



8. Remedy by tribunal
Everyone has the right to remedy by a competent tribunal.



9. Freedom from arbitrary arrest
No one shall be subject to arbitrary arrest, detention or exile.



10. Fair public hearing
Everyone has the right to a fair public hearing.



11. Innocent until proven guilty
Everyone has the right to be considered innocent until proven guilty.



12. Privacy
No one has the right to interfere with your privacy, family, or home.

13. Freedom of movement

Everyone has the right to freedom of movement in and out of the country...



14. Asylum
Everyone has the right to seek asylum in other countries from persecution.



15. Nationality
Everyone has the right to a nationality.

16. Marriage and family



Everyone has the right to marriage and to raise a family.



17. Property
Everyone has the right to own property.

18. Freedom of belief

Everyone has the right to freedom of belief and religion.



19. Freedom of opinion
Everyone has the right to freedom of opinion and expression.

20. Freedom of assembly

Everyone has the right to freedom of peaceful assembly and association.



21. Take part in Government

Everyone has the right to take part in the government of their country.



22. Social Security
Everyone has the right to social security.



23. Work
Everyone has the right to desirable work and to join trade unions.



24. Rest and leisure
Everyone has the right to rest and leisure.
